I. RELIEF REQUESTED

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c), Patent Owner Realtime Adaptive

Mr. Milkey has read and will comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials set forth in part 42 of title 37 of the Code of Federal Regulations. *Id.* at ¶ 7. Mr. Milkey understands and accepts that he will be subject to the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 et. seq. and disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a). *Id.* at ¶ 8. Mr. Milkey is familiar with the subject matter at issue in this proceeding through his review of the underlying patent, the record, and discussions with Patent Owner's counsel. *Id.* at \P 9.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Patent Owner respectfully requests that the Board admit James A. Milkey *pro hac vice* in this proceeding.
