On April 3, 2019, Petitioner Netflix, Inc. filed an objection to Patent Owner's Exhibit 2002, a purported copy of the deposition transcript of James A. Storer, because it "contains highlighting by the Patent Owner that do not appear in the original transcript." Paper 27. In an attempt to resolve the objection, the parties requested leave to file a motion to expunge the originally filed Exhibit 2002 and to replace it with another copy of the deposition transcript. We granted leave and the parties filed their Joint Motion to Replace Exhibit 2002 on April 25, 2019. Paper 29. Under the circumstances, we determine the parties have provided good cause for granting their motion.

#### ORDER

It is:

ORDERED that the Parties' Joint Motion to Replace Exhibit 2002 is *granted*;

FURTHER ORDERED that Patent Owner' Exhibit 2002 is expunged.
