PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT ON REMAND

¹ IPR2018-01335 and IPR2018-01336 have been consolidated with the instant proceeding.

Pursuant to 37 § C.F.R. 42.70(a) and the Board’s February 23, 2022 Scheduling Order on Remand (Paper 34), Petitioner respectfully requests oral argument, virtually, for the trial currently scheduled for August 4, 2022. Petitioner requests to appear virtually for the oral argument, pursuant to the Board’s June 23, 2022 guidance.

Petitioner specifies the following issues to be argued:

- The broadest reasonable interpretation of the claim term “hardware buffer” in U.S. Patent No. 8,838,949.
- The meaning of the term “system memory” as it relates to the “hardware buffer.”
- The applicability of the broadest reasonable interpretation of “hardware buffer” to the asserted prior art disclosures.
- Whether the Board can resolve the prior art challenge to the patentability of claims 16 and 17 despite the potential indefiniteness of the means-plus function terms, along with whether these means-plus-function terms of claims 16 and 17 are indefinite.
- Respond to any arguments raised in the Patent Owner’s Response Brief on Remand and Patent Owner’s Sur-Reply on Remand.

- All grounds on which trial was instituted, including all issues raised by the parties' papers.
- Respond to issues specified by Patent Owner in its request for oral argument.

Additionally, Petitioner reserves the right to address any arguments presented by Patent Owner and any other issues about which the Board wishes to hear argument during the oral hearing.

Petitioner requests the ability to use a computer, projector, and screen to display possible demonstratives and/or exhibits.
