## Notice of Intent to Issue Ex Parte Reexamination Certificate

This is an *ex parte* reexamination of claims 14 and 30 of United States Patent Number 7,397,431 to Baliarda et al. (hereinafter "the '431 patent"), entitled "MULTILEVEL ANTENNA" based on the reexamination request filed 10/09/2013. Claims 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 12, 13, 17, 21, 22, 24-27, 29 and 31 were disclaimed by a statutory disclaimer filed 9/10/2013, published in the Official Gazette 11/12/2013, and are therefore no longer a part of the patent and thus not subject to reexamination. Note that a statutory disclaimer takes effect upon the time of its proper filing, and its effect is that the claims *never existed*. Vectra Fitness Inc. v. TNWK Corp., 49 USPQ2d 1144, 1146-47 (Fed. Cir. 1998). Reexamination was not requested of claims 2, 3, 6, 9-11, 15, 16, 18-20, 23, 28 and 32-37 and did not assert the existence of a substantial new question of patentability (SNQ) for such claims; thus, such claims will not be reexamined. See MPEP 2243.

Patent Owner filed an amendment on 12/17/2014, adding new claims 38-43; and canceling previously disclaimed claims 1, 12 and 13. Note that claims 1, 12 and 13 were already disclaimed; therefore, they are not cancelled now (cannot cancel claims that do not exist).

## Statement of Reasons for Patentability and/or Confirmation

Claims 14, 30 and 38-43 are patentable.

The examiner has no opinion as to the claims that were not reexamined. The following is an examiner's statement of reasons for patentability of the claim found confirmed/patentable in this reexamination proceeding:

There is not taught or disclosed in the prior art including a multi-band antenna having the first level of structural detail comprising the overall structure having the first geometry configured to operate at the first frequency band and the second level of structural detail within the first level of structural detail having a second geometry configured to operate at the second frequency band; and the perimeter of the multilevel structure having a different number of sides than each of the geometric elements that compose the multilevel structure, as called for in claims 14 and 30. Newly added claims 38-40 and 41-43 depending from claims 14 and 30, respectively; therefore, they're also patentable.

#### Remarks

The arguments presented in the Response and the Declarations submitted have been fully considered.

The examiner agrees with Patent Owner, as similarly indicated in the 12/08/2014 interview summary, that Yanagisawa and Johnson do not meet the amended features reciting the first level of structural detail comprising the overall structure having the first geometry configured to operate at the first frequency band and the second level of structural detail within the first level of structural detail having a second geometry configured to operate at the second frequency band. In addition, it is agreed that Guo and Misra lack the feature of the perimeter of the multilevel structure having a different number of sides than each of the geometric elements that compose the multilevel structure.
