HOW TO USE YOUR LANTUS[®] SOLOSTAR[®]

A STEP BY STEP GUIDE TO USING YOUR LANTUS[®] SOLOSTAR[®] PEN

This quick reference guide is a short version of the instruction leaflet. It is designed to help make it easier to use your Lantus SoloStar pen. Reading this guide will help to make sure that you inject the right amount of insulin every time. Other factors can affect your blood sugar levels, and that can affect your blood sugar levels.

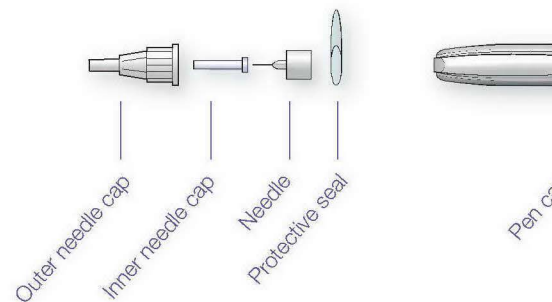

GETTING TO KNOW YOUR PEN AND ITS PARTS

The Lantus[®] SoloSTAR[®] pen was designed with a simple-to-push injection button and large dosing window.



What is Lantus[®] (insulin glargine injection) 100 Units/mL?

Prescription Lantus[®] is a long-acting insulin used to treat adults with type 2 diabetes and adults and pediatric patients (children 6 years and older) with type 1 diabetes for the control of high blood sugar.

Important Safety Information for Lantus[®] (insulin glargine injection) 100 Units/mL

Do not take Lantus[®] during episodes of low blood sugar or if you are allergic to insulin or any of the inactive ingredients in Lantus[®].

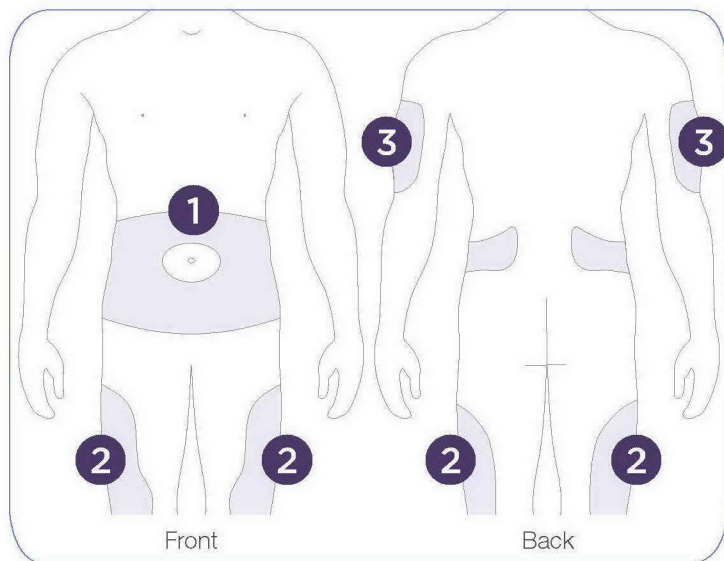

CHOOSING AN INJECTION SITE

The three possible injection sites are:

- 1 your abdomen, 2 your thighs, and 3 your upper arms. These areas have more fat and fewer nerve endings. You may feel less discomfort in these areas.
- Each time you inject, use a different site within these three areas, because repeatedly injecting in the same spot can cause discomfort.

INJECTION AREAS TO AVOID

When injecting in these three areas:

- Avoid the two-inch circle around the navel.
- Avoid injecting too close to the elbow.
- Avoid the forearm and hand, where there is fatty tissue.



- Always rotate your injection sites as advised by your doctor.
- Never force the needle through the skin. Too much force can cause injury.
- Never inject into a bruise, scar, or area of infection.
- Never rub the injection site.

Important Safety Information

Before starting Lantus®, tell your doctor about all the conditions, including if you are pregnant or planning to become pregnant or planning to breast-feed.

HOW TO DISPOSE OF NEEDLES



Place used needles in sharps containers, which you can buy at your local drugstore.



If a sharps container isn't available, use a strong plastic bottle that cannot be punctured, such as a bleach or laundry detergent bottle. Make sure the cap is on tight. When you're ready to dispose of the bottle, put tape over the cap and be sure to write "SHARPS" on the bottle.



Take your sharps container to appropriate collection sites that may include doctors' offices, hospitals, pharmacies, health departments, fire stations, or other locations.

Don't flush used sharps down the toilet or drop them into a sewer drain.



Don't put used sharps in soda cans, milk cartons, glass bottles, coffee cans, or containers that can be broken or punctured.



Always discard the pen with the pen cap on. You can discard the pen in regular trash.

HOW TO STORE YOUR LANTUS® SOLOSTAR



Before opening, keep pens in the refrigerator (36° to 46° F).



Lantus® can be stored at room temperature (up to 77° F) for up to 30 days after the expiration date.



Before you inject, let the pen sit at room temperature for one hour or two—cooling the solution may affect the accuracy of the dose.



Do not allow Lantus® to freeze. Do not store Lantus® next to a freezer. If the Lantus® solution is frozen, do not use it.



Keep Lantus® away from heat and light.

Important Safety Information

Heart failure can occur if you take medicines called TZDs (thiazolidinediones) with insulin. If you have had heart failure or other heart problems, heart failure may get worse with treatment with TZDs and insulin. Tell your doctor if you have ever been stopped by your doctor if you have heart failure, including:

- Shortness of breath
- Sudden weight gain
- Swelling of your ankles

HOW TO STORE YOUR OPENED LANTUS® SOLOSTAR® PEN



After its first use, don't refrigerate the Lantus® SoloSTAR® pen. Keep it at room temperature only (below 86°F).



After 28 days, throw your opened Lantus® away—even if it still has insulin in it.



Keep Lantus® away from direct heat and light.



Don't leave Lantus® in a hot car in direct sun, or in a freezing car overnight. If Lantus® gets too hot or freezes, it will have to be thrown away.

Important Safety Information for Lantus® (cont'd)

Tell your doctor about all the medications you take, including OTC medicines, vitamins, and supplements, including herbal supplements.

Lantus® should be taken once a day at the same time every day. Test your blood sugar levels while using insulin, such as Lantus®. Do not make any changes to your dose or type of insulin without talking to your healthcare provider. Any change of insulin should be made cautiously and only under medical supervision.

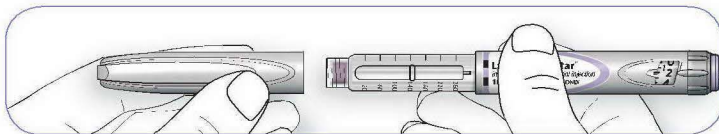

HOW TO USE YOUR LANTUS® (INSULIN GLARGINE INJECTION) 100 UNITS/ML SOLOSTAR® PEN IN 6 STEPS

These instructions are supplied as a guide only. Read the full instruction leaflet included in this kit before you use Lantus® SoloSTAR® for the first time. To help ensure an accurate dose each time, follow all steps in the leaflet.

STEP 1. GET READY

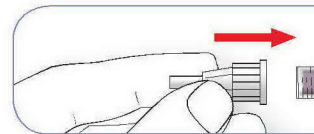
- Remove the pen cap with clean hands.
- Check the reservoir to make sure the insulin is clear and colorless and has no particles—if not, use another pen.



- Always store UNOPENED Lantus® SoloSTAR® pens in the refrigerator.
- Always wash your hands with soap and water before an injection.
- Always check the expiration date of the pen.
- Never inject cold insulin. Wait until pen warms up to room temperature.
- Always use a new needle.
- Never refrigerate the pen after opening it.
- Never play with the dial before using it; this may prevent jamming.

STEP 2. ATTACH THE NEEDLE

- Wipe the pen tip (rubber stopper) with the pen, and screw the needle onto the pen.
- Do not make the needle too tight as you push it on.



- After you have attached the needle, tap the pen (you will need it to remove air bubbles).
- Remove the inner needle cap.
- **Insulin pens, needles, and needles are for single use only. Do NOT reuse.**

STEP 3. PERFORM AN INJECTION

- Dial a test dose of 2 units.
- Hold pen with the needle pointing down. Tap the insulin reservoir so that insulin moves to the top of the needle. This will give you the most accurate dose.
- Press the injection button to inject insulin. Check to see that insulin comes out of the needle. The dial will automatically stop at the dose you performed the test.
- If no insulin comes out, repeat the test. If there is still no insulin, use a new needle and do the test again.
