- the grounds of unpatentability of claims 1 and 2 of the '676 patent presented in the Petition including:
 - o whether claims 1 and 2 are unpatentable under Section 103 over HomeRF (Ex. 1006);



- o whether claims 1 and 2 are unpatentable under Section 103 over HomeRF in view of HomeRF Tutorial (Ex. 1008);
- o whether claims 1 and 2 are unpatentable under Section 103 over HomeRF in view of HomeRF Liaison Report (Ex. 1009); and
- o whether claims 1 and 2 are unpatentable under Section 103 over Lansford (Ex. 1012).

Petitioner reserves the right to address any arguments presented by Patent Owner and any other issues about which the Board wishes to hear argument during any oral hearing in this proceeding.

Petitioner requests 60 minutes to address all issues for this proceeding.
