I. INTRODUCTION

Patent Owner Wistaria Trading Ltd. submits this Preliminary Response to the Petition for *Inter Partes* Review of United States Patent No. 9,021,602 (“the ’602 Patent”) filed by Petitioner DISH Network L.L.C. (“Petitioner”) (the “Petition” or “Pet.”).

The Board should dismiss the Petition in its entirety at least because, as Patent Owner shows below, dispositive claim elements are entirely missing from the combination of references asserted in each of the Grounds of the Petition.

II. THE ’602 PATENT

A. Overview of the ’602 Patent

The ’602 Patent is titled “DATA PROTECTION METHOD AND DEVICE.” The ’602 Patent describes an “apparatus and method for encoding and decoding additional information into a digital information in an integral manner. More particularly, the invention relates to a method and device for data protection.” EX1001, Abstract. The apparatus and method stores application software in non-transient memory of a computer. The application software stores, in a personalization data resource, computer configuration information of a computer as well as a license code entered as a result of prompting the user of the computer. EX1001, 16:3–13. The application software then generates a proper
