Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.70, the Board's Scheduling Order dated February 11, 2020 (Paper 8), Petitioner Microsoft Corporation ("Petitioner") respectfully requests oral argument, currently scheduled for November 10, 2020.

5,940,773 (Exhibit 1006) in view of "Communication Device Inactivity Password Lock" (Exhibit 1008); and

• The interpretation of certain claim limitations of U.S. Patent No. 6,836,654 (Exhibit 1001).

Petitioner reserves the right to address any arguments presented by Patent Owner and any other issues about which the Board wishes to hear argument during any oral hearing in this proceeding.
