#### [57] ABSTRACT

A retrofocus type super wide angle lens system includes a front lens group of negative power and a rear lens group of positive power, arranged in this order from the object side. The front lens group consists of a negative meniscus first lens element with a convex surface facing the object side and a second lens element having at least one aspherical surface, arranged in this order from the object side. The aspherical second lens element is shaped such that it forms a biconcave lens in the vicinity of the optical axis and forms a negative meniscus lens with a convex surface located on the object side at a peripheral portion thereof.






FIG. 2 FIG. 3 FIG. 4 1.25 3 3 d LINEc LINE g LINE--30 (%) 30 -.02 .02 -.02 .02 **SPHERICAL ASTIGMATISM** DISTORTION **ABERRATION**













FIG. 7 FIG. 8 FIG. 9 1.25 58.4 58.4 d LINE -S -c LINE g LINE 、 -30 (%) 30 -.02 .02 -.02 SPHERICAL ABERRATION **DISTORTION ASTIGMATISM** 




