**adjective**

UK /,pri:.di'faɪnd/ US /,pri:.di'faɪnd/



**decided, set, or arranged before something is done:**

- *The chart can be filled out with a predefined set of values.*
- *What happens when usage falls below predefined thresholds?*

## — More examples

- *We don't have any predefined criteria.*
- *The computer generates a random number at a predefined interval.*
- *You cannot delete predefined objects.*
