Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. §§ 141, 142, and 319, and 37 C.F.R. §§ 90.2-90.3, notice is hereby given that Petitioner Palo Alto Networks, Inc. and Juniper Networks, Inc. (“Petitioner”) appeals to the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit from the Final Written Decision of the Patent Trial and Appeal Board (“Board”) entered September 8, 2021 (Paper 48) in IPR2020-00337, and from all underlying orders, decisions, rulings, and opinions.
