SCHEDULING ORDER

The Parties have come before the undersigned for telephonic Conferences on May 21, 2020, May 29, 2020, June 3, 2020 and June 4, 2020 to discuss pre-trial issues; and the parties having continued to meet and confer on pre-trial and settlement issues; and the Court having set a trial date of September 28, 2020; and for good cause shown;

IT IS ON THIS 11th DAY OF JUNE 2020, ORDERED THAT:

1. On **June 25, 2020**, the parties shall file their *in limine* motions with the Court. Each party shall file a single supporting brief with a short introduction, followed by no more than five pages of legal argument for each distinct *in limine* motion. On **July 9, 2020**, each party shall then file a single opposition brief with no more than five pages of legal argument in opposition to each distinct *in limine* motion. On **July 16, 2020**, each party shall then file a single reply brief with no more than three pages of legal argument in reply to the opposition for each distinct *in limine* motion.

2. On **July 23, 2020** the parties shall submit the proposed Joint Final Pretrial Order to the Court. The Joint Final Pretrial Order will not include proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, which shall be reserved and submitted to the Court post-trial.

3. The parties will appear by telephone for a Final Pretrial Conference before the undersigned on **August 11, 2020**. Plaintiffs shall initiate the call.

4. Trial in this matter will begin on **September 28, 2020**.

5. The parties shall report on any further settlement efforts during the next Case Management Conference.

6. The parties shall continue to meet and confer regarding trial length, witnesses, and contested issues for trial.

7. The parties shall meet and confer regarding selection of a mediator. If the parties are unable to agree upon a mediator, each side shall send the names of three proposed mediators to the Court by **June 18, 2020**.
