**PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR REFUND OF  
POST-INSTITUTION FEES**

On February 20, 2020, Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd. (“Petitioner”) filed a petition (Paper No. 1) for *inter partes* review of U.S. Patent No. 8,416,862 with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board. In accordance with the fee schedule specified in 37 C.F.R. § 42.15(a), Petitioner deposited an electronic payment at the time of filing of the petition, including \$15,500 for fees associated with Petitioner’s request for review and a further \$15,000 for post-institution fees. On August 24, 2020, the Board entered a Decision (Paper No. 10) terminating the proceeding. On September 23, 2020, Petitioner filed a request for rehearing regarding the denial of institution (Paper No. 11). On October 14, 2020, in light of the parties having settled their dispute, Petitioner filed a motion for withdrawal of its rehearing request (Paper No. 12), and on October 27, 2020 the Board granted that motion. (Paper No. 13.) Therefore, Petitioner requests a refund in the amount of \$15,000 to be paid to Deposit Account Number 50-2613 for the post-institution fees, which are no longer necessary.
