

Text Order DENYING 104 Motion to Stay Case entered by Judge Alan D Albright. Before the Court is Defendants' motion to stay pending conclusion of an instituted IPR. The Court DENIES this motion for at least the following reasons: (1) The Court strongly believes the Seventh Amendment, (2) This case has been pending since 2017 and staying the case would only further delay its resolution, (3) Denying the stay would allow the Parties to obtain a more timely and complete resolution of infringement, invalidity, and damages issues, and (4) Plaintiff opposes the stay.
