**PETITIONER'S UPDATED MANDATORY NOTICES
PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. § 42.8**

Petitioner Google LLC provides this updated mandatory notice under 37 C.F.R. § 42.8 to update the Board on the status of the litigation where Uniloc asserted the same patent challenged in this proceeding. On December 22, 2020, the Northern District of California found that at least Fortress Credit Co. LLC held sufficient rights in the challenged patent that Uniloc lacked standing to sue. The court then dismissed the litigation for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. *See generally Uniloc 2017 LLC v. Google LLC*, No. 4:20-cv-05345-YGR, Dkt. 210 (N.D. Cal. Dec. 22, 2020) (single order addressing eleven cases). Uniloc filed a notice of appeal on December 31, 2020.
