2	JUDGE BEAMER: Good afternoon. This is Judge
3	Beamer. Are we all ready to start?
4	With me are Judges White and Wormmeester.
5	This is Fitbit Inc. v. Philips North America
6	LLC, IPR 2020-783.
7	Could the parties introduce themselves and
8	spell their name.
9	MR. PALYS: Good afternoon, Your Honors.
10	This is Joseph Palys for petitioner. My last
11	name is spelled P-a-l-y-s.
12	And today I'm joined with my colleagues Naveen
13	Modi, Yar Chaikovsky, and David Okano.
14	MR. THOMPSON: Your Honor, I believe that
15	that, if I'm not mistaken, was everybody for the
16	petitioner, and in such case, I'm pleased to introduce
17	myself. My name is Eley Thompson of Foley & Lardner on
18	behalf of the patent owner, Philips North America.
19	And with me from my firm are Rubin Rodriguez,
20	and you see G. Beck there, but that's George Beck on
21	the boxes on the video. So the three of us are
22	appearing on behalf of the patent owner.
23	I will be presenting or arguing.
24	JUDGE BEAMER: Thank you.
25	So this is a video hearing and our first
26	priority is to make sure everyone can be heard. So if

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1	If we turn to our petitioner demonstratives
2	that I assume that Your Honors have in front of you, we
3	can turn to Slide 2, and I will begin.
4	In this proceeding, the challenged claims, as
5	you know, are at issue across seven grounds, and the
6	grounds are split up, basically, across two primary
7	references, and that's Jacobsen and Say.
8	Based on how trials progress and given the
9	issues that have been identified through patent owner's
10	papers, the issues have been really narrowed down to a
11	few items.
12	If we go to Slide 3.
13	Therefore, for purposes of today, Your Honors,
14	I'd like to first focus on the security mechanism term
15	and discuss how the prior art discloses and/or suggests
16	that feature, and then, depending on how much time is
17	left, I'll try to respond to the patent owner's
18	arguments with respect to the dependent claims.
19	Of course, the Board is driving the bus here,
20	so if any questions, kind of, divert from this intended
21	path, obviously, I'll do my best to answer those
22	questions.
23	So with that, let's turn to Slide 6, please.
24	And on Slide 6 we see Claim 1 of the '233
25	patent, and that's the sole, independent claim at issue
26	here



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
