1. My name is Lee Sowell. I am employed by One World Technologies, Inc., d/b/a Techtronic Industries Power Equipment, the Petitioner in this matter. My title is Group President – Outdoor Power Equipment.

2. I frequently refer to Techtronic Industries Power Equipment by the shorthand “TTi.” When I used the term “TTi” in my email to Mr. Clancy, I was referring to my employer, One World Technologies, Inc., d/b/a Techtronic Industries Power Equipment.

3. I understand that One World Technologies, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of Techtronic Industries North America, Inc., which is a wholly owned subsidiary of Techtronic Industries Co. Ltd., a publicly traded company on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange. Homelite Consumer Products, Inc., is a wholly owned subsidiary of Techtronic Industries North America, Inc.

4. The three companies I identified above—Techtronic Industries North America, Inc., Techtronic Industries Co. Ltd., and Homelite Consumer Products, Inc.—do not exercise control over the daily operations of One World Technologies, Inc. One World Technologies, Inc. had no obligation to consult with any of those three companies or obtain their permission to file the IPR and PGR petitions in this matter.
