Overview of Argument

- All Instituted Grounds: Petition Uses Improper Hindsight
 - Improperly uses '277 patent as a guide to obviousness
 - No motivation to modify Ogino with Bareau
 - Overlapping lens elements ignore manufacturability
- Ground 1:
 - Ignores Bareau Teaching of Relative Illumination
- Ground 2:
 - Hindsight analysis ignores standard industry design practices
 - Inconsistent Characterization of Ogino Example 5
