 Obviousness over Parulski and Konno
- Ground 2: Claims 2-4 and 24-26
 Obviousness over Parulski, Konno, and Szeliski
- Ground 3: Claims 5-9 and 27-31
 Obviousness over Parulski, Konno, Szeliski, and Segall
- Ground 4: Claims 15 and 37
 Obviousness over Parulski, Konno, and Stein



Overview of Argument

- All Instituted Grounds:
 - Erroneous claim construction equating POV with FOV
 - Lack of motivation to combine multiple Parulski embodiments
 Konno
 - Parulski's "range map" does not teach a "fused image with a poor of view (POV) of the Wide camera"
- Grounds 2, 3, and 4
 - Combinations with and Szeliski, Segall, and Stein motivated by hindsight



Claim Construction



"fused image with a point of view (POV) of the Wide cam

Corephotonics's Construction	Apple's First Construction
positions and shapes of objects reflect the POV of the Wide	"a fused image that maintains to Wide camera's field of view or to the Wide camera's field of view position"
