1677, in the meaning defined above

History and Etymology for configure

Middle English *configuren* (as past participle *configurid*) "to model on, conform to," borrowed from Middle French & Latin; Middle French *configurer* "to compare, form," borrowed from Latin *configūrāre* "to mold, shape," from *con-* <u>con-</u> + figūrāre "to shape, form, make a likeness of" — more at <u>figure entry 2</u>


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
