4 Q. Hello, Mr. Orlov.

5 A. Hello.

6 Q. Please state your full legal name.

7 A. My name is Vladimir Orlov.

8 Q. Thank you.

12 Q. You're here to answer questions about declarations you
13 submitted in two cases before the U.S. Patent and
14 Trademark Office; is that right?

18 A. I don't have these numbers in front of me right now,

2 Q. Okay. I'll go over just a few ground rules to keep us
3 on the same page. First, I'd ask that you wait until
4 the question is finished before you respond to the
5 question to make sure we're not speaking over each
6 other. Is that okay?

7 A. Yeah, sure.

8 Q. And second, I'd ask that you speak clearly so that we
9 can hear and record your answers rather than using
10 gestures or head gestures. Is that okay?

11 A. Yeah, I'll do my best. Okay.

12 Q. And if you don't understand a question, will you
13 please tell me?

14 A. Sure.

15 Q. If you don't ask to clarify, I'll assume that you
16 understood the question; is that okay?

17 A. Yeah, okay.

18 Q. Counsel for patent owner may object to questions I ask
19 from time to time, but unless you're instructed
20 specifically not to answer, you'll still need to
21 answer the question. Okay?

22 A. Yeah, okay.

- 1 Q. Are you under the influence of anything, such as
2 medications, that might make it difficult for you to
3 understand and answer my questions today?
- 4 A. No, I am not.
- 5 Q. Is there any other reason you cannot provide your
6 complete and accurate testimony today?
- 7 A. No, I don't think there is such reason.
- 8 Q. Are you alone today in the room you are in, Mr. Orlov?
- 9 A. Yes, I am.
- 10 Q. And what equipment are you using for the interview
11 today?
- 12 A. Just my laptop and, well, screens connected to the
13 laptop.
- 14 Q. Do you have a phone with you in the room?
- 15 A. Yes. It's near me, but it's switched off. I mean,
16 the sound is switched off.
- 17 Q. And do you agree not to use that phone during the
18 questioning today for any reason?
- 19 A. Yes, I do.
- 20 Q. Do you have any hard copies of any documents in front
21 of you today?
- 22 A. Yes. I have a copy of my declaration and copy of a

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
