ORDER

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On May 11, 2021, Petitioner filed a Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Michael J. Summersgill and, separately, a Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Todd Zubler in each of the above-identified proceedings. IPR2020-01265, Exs. 1020 (Summersgill), 1021 (Zubler); IPR2020-01302, Exs. 1031 (Summersgill), 1032 (Zubler). Patent Owner has not opposed the Motions.

Upon review of the record before us, we determine that the requirements of 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c) have been met and there is good cause to admit Messrs. Summersgill and Zubler *pro hac vice*.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED that Petitioner’s Motions for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Michael J. Summersgill and Todd Zubler are *granted*; Messrs. Summersgill and Zubler are authorized to act only as back-up counsel in the above-identified proceedings;

FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner is to continue to have a registered practitioner represent it as lead counsel for the above-identified proceedings;

FURTHER ORDERED that Messrs. Summersgill and Zubler are to comply with the Consolidated Trial Practice Guide² (84 Fed. Reg. 64,280 (Nov. 21, 2019)), and the Board’s Rules of Practice for Trials as set forth in Part 42 of Title 37, Code of Federal Regulations; and
