4 MICHAEL JONES,
5 duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

6 EXAMINATION

7 BY MS. CHRISTNER:

8 Q. Well, good morning, Mr. Jones. I am here

2 A. Okay.

3 Q. First, and this can be harder over video, so
4 we can do our best here, but we'll try our best to
5 speak one at a time. So even if you think that
6 you understand the question, I'm going to ask you,
7 please make sure you wait until I finish the
8 question and then I'll try to do the same while
9 you're giving your answers.

10 Does that sound okay?

11 A. Yes.

12 Q. And also for the court reporter's benefit, I
13 just ask that you make sure that you give your
14 answers verbally instead of nodding or shaking
15 your head, and we'll both try to speak slowly and
16 clearly for the record.

21 please just ask me to rephrase it. I'm happy to
22 do that. I will assume that if you do answer my
