I represent Patent Owner in the above-listed IPRs. I am writing to request leave to file a motion to strike certain improper new arguments and evidence contained in Petitioner's reply briefs, or in the alternative to file a paper that identifies improper new evidence and argument in connection with Patent Owner's sur-replies. In particular, we would move to strike:

- 1. Petitioner's new obviousness argument based on additional modifications to Kontos that were not contained in the original petitions (see, e.g. IPR2020-01342, Paper 40 at 11, 14-15, 19-20; IPR2020-01344, Paper 37 at 7, 13, 17-18). This aspect of our motion applies to IPR2020-01342 and -01344.
- 2. Petitioner's new obviousness argument based on the theory that Ressemann's collar discloses three inclined portions, not two (see, e.g. IPR2020-01343, Paper 46 at 28-31, 34; IPR2020-01344, Paper 37 at 13-16). This aspect of our motion applies to IPR2020-01343 and -01344.
- 3. Petitioner's new evidence purporting to show stents that were insertable through an opening of 0.046 inches: Ex-1806 ¶¶27-34; Ex-1807, ¶43; Ex-1015b, 189; Ex-1802; Ex-1803; Ex-1804 (see, e.g. IPR2020-01341, Paper 51 at 33-34; IPR2020-01343, Paper 46 at 25-26). This aspect of our motion applies to IPR2020-01341 and -1343.

Patent Owner has conferred with Petitioner, and Petitioner opposes Patent Owner's request. The parties are available for a call with the Board on Thursday (9/16) between 10am-1pm ET and Friday (9/17) after 1pm ET.
