Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.70(a), and the Board's October 7, 2021 Revised Scheduling Order (Paper 42), Petitioner Intel Corporation respectfully requests oral argument, which is currently scheduled for January 6, 2022, on at least the following issues:

1. The unpatentability of challenged claims 1-19 of the '867 patent as set forth in each of the instituted grounds;

2. Patent Owner's failure to meet its many burdens on the Revised Motion to Amend, including by proposing amendments that add new matter, lack written description support, and improperly enlarge the original claim scope;

3. The unpatentability of Patent Owner's proposed amended claims 20-38;

4. Any issues subsidiary to the above issues, including, but not limited to, publication status, claim construction, priority date, assessment of evidence, and admissibility and sufficiency of evidence; and

5. Any other issues raised in papers filed in the present proceeding, including issues raised in any papers filed between today and the oral hearing.

The Office's notice regarding oral hearings occurring after March 13, 2020 requires that hearings be conducted remotely by video or telephone until further notice. Petitioner is available to participate in that manner. To the extent that notice is not in effect by the time of the hearing in this proceeding and the Board would prefer to hold the hearing in-person, Petitioner respectfully requests that the hearing be held at the USPTO headquarters in Alexandria.

Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board provide audio-visual equipment to display demonstrative exhibits, including a projector and a screen configured to display documents from a laptop computer (e.g., PowerPoint display) and ELMO document camera/projector if available.

Petitioner believes the ordinary amount of time set forth in the Trial Practice Guide (*i.e.*, one hour of argument per side) will be sufficient to present its argument in this proceeding.
