Patent Owner writes to address two issues.

1. By agreement of the parties, the deposition of Petitioner's expert, Dr. Roy, was taken on Dec. 6, 2021, only one day in advance of the due date for Patent Owner's Response and Motion to Amend. As a result, Patent Owner submitted the rough transcript of the Roy deposition as EX2014 and cited thereto in its Patent Owner response (Paper 28).
