Learn how to use your iPhone to set up your AirPods.

Use your iPhone to set up your AirPods

If you're setting up your AirPods for the first time, make sure that you have an iPhone with the [latest version of iOS](#). Then follow these steps:

1. Go to the Home screen.
2. With your AirPods in the charging case, open the charging case, and hold it next to your iPhone. A setup animation appears on your iPhone.
3. Tap Connect.
4. If you have AirPods Pro, read the next three screens.
5. If you have AirPods Pro or AirPods (2nd generation) and you set up "Hey Siri" on your iPhone already, then "Hey Siri" is ready to use with your AirPods. If you haven't set up "Hey Siri" already and you have AirPods Pro or AirPods (2nd generation), you'll be guided through the setup.
6. Tap Done.
7. If you're signed in to iCloud, your AirPods are set up automatically with any of your supported devices that are signed in to iCloud with the same Apple ID.
