- 1. A system comprising:
- a portable switching device coupled to a portable electronic device:

wherein:

the switching device and the electronic device are configured to selectively couple to each other employing magnetic force from a first magnet disposed within the switching device;

the switching device comprises a first case;

the electronic device comprises a second case and an electronic circuit that is responsive to the switching device; the electronic device comprises at least one element selected from the group consisting of beveled edges, ridges, recessed areas, grooves, slots, indented shapes, bumps, raised shapes, and combinations thereof; configured to correspond to complementary surface elements on the switching device;
