

Text Order DENYING 104 Motion to Stay Case entered by Judge Alan D Albright. Before the Court is Defendants' motion to stay pending conclusion of an instituted IPR. The Court DENIES this motion for at least the following reasons:&nbsp;&nbsp;(1) The Court strongly believes the Seventh Amendment,&nbsp;&nbsp;(2) This case has been pending since 2017 and staying the case would only further delay its resolution,&nbsp;&nbsp;(3) Denying the stay would allow the Parties to obtain a more timely and complete resolution of infringement, invalidity, and damages issues, and&nbsp;&nbsp;(4) Plaintiff opposes the stay.
