USB Working Gr

- **USB Implementers Forum (USB-IF)**
 - own specifications, legal rights, labeling
- **USB Core Team**
 - Compaq, Intel, HP, Lucent, Microsoft, NEC, Philips
- **Device Working Groups (DWG)**
 - one group for each device type
 - form as needed, write specifications, submit to Core
 - meet every 6 weeks
- **USB-on-the-Go Working Group**
 - New working group, established in Feb, 2000
 - reports directly to USB Core Team



Miniature Connector

- **USB connectors Series A and B too large for small devices**
- **DWG started to investigate in late 98**
 - Cable & Connector Working Group (CCWG) responsible for developing standard
- **in June 99, CCWG formed “Miniconn” Subcommittee**
- **Miniconn Subcommittee tasked with:**
 - soliciting industry input
 - coming back with recommendations
