The above-entitled matter came on for hearing on, Friday,  
December 16, 2022, commencing at 1:00 p.m. EST, by video/by telephone.

1                   P R O C E E D I N G S

2           JUDGE TROCK: Good day, everyone. This is Judge  
3 Trock. With me on the Panel today are Judges Beamer and  
4 Browne.

5           This is in the matter of IPR2021-01413,  
6 regarding Patent Number 10,621,228, in the matter of  
7 Unified Patents v. MemoryWeb.

8           We'll start with appearances. Counsel for  
9 Petitioner.

10          MR. BARAZESH: Good afternoon, Your Honor. This  
11 is Ellyar Barazesh, for Petitioner. Also with me is  
12 Roshan Mansinghani and Michelle Aspen.

13          JUDGE TROCK: Okay, Counsel.

14          Appearances for Patent Owner.

15          MS. HAYES: Good afternoon, Your Honors.  
16 Jennifer Hayes from Nixon Peabody for Patent Owner,  
17 MemoryWeb. With me today is Mr. Werber, also from Nixon  
18 Peabody.

19          I also understand that members -- that  
20 MemoryWeb itself is listening on the public line of this  
21 hearing, as well are my colleagues, Mr. Schwartz and Mr.  
22 Christopher.

23          JUDGE TROCK: Thank you.

24          So thank you all for attending this hearing

1 today. First, I wanted to let everybody know that this  
2 hearing will be broken up into two sessions. There will  
3 be a public session that we will have first, and then,  
4 there will be a confidential section that we will have  
5 following that. And between the two, though, we will be  
6 disconnecting the public line so that only the  
7 Panel and counsel will be attending the confidential  
8 section.

9       There is a court reporter here today who will  
10 be transcribing everything that's being said.

11       So before we begin, I just wanted to cover a  
12 few things. First, our primary concern here is your  
13 right to be heard. If at any time during this  
14 proceeding you encounter a technical or other difficulty  
15 that you believe undermines your ability to represent  
16 your client, let us know right away, and contact one of  
17 the team members that have provided you with the  
18 connection information today.

19       Second, when you are not speaking, please mute  
20 your microphone. That will make it easier for everybody  
21 to hear and for the court reporter to take an accurate  
22 transcript.

23       Third, each time you speak, please identify  
24 yourself. That will also aid the court reporter in  
25 preparing a transcript.

1           And fourth, we have the entire record, your  
2   Demonstratives, all the exhibits, and so forth. When  
3   you are referring them, please refer to them by exhibit  
4   and page number, so that we can -- and give us a moment  
5   to pull them up on our screens, and so that we can also  
6   have that information for the transcript as well.

7           Now, before we begin, Petitioner has 75 minutes to present their entire  
8   case today, and Patent Owner has 60 minutes. We had  
9   indicated before that you can allocate that  
10   amount of time as you wish.

11          Petitioner, how would you like to allocate  
12   the 75 minutes of time? And let's start with how much  
13   time do you want to allocate to the confidential  
14   section?

15          MR. BARAZESH: Thank you, Your Honor. So we'd  
16   like to allocate ten minutes for the confidential  
17   section.

18          JUDGE TROCK: Okay. So that will give you 65  
19   minutes for the public section and ten minutes for the  
20   confidential section.

21          Patent Owner, how would you like to allocate  
22   your time?

23          MS. HAYES: We would also like ten minutes for  
24   the confidential portion.
