## Introduction

- Notably, the Code200 Petitioners (“Oxylabs”) allege that Crowds asserted claims of the ‘319 and ‘519 patents in a jury trial in Case No. 2:19-cv-395 (E.D. Tex.) (the ‘319 and ‘519 jury trial).
  - The independent claims recite a “**second server**” which is configured to receive data from a first server and to store the data in a second server.
- **The jury rejected the Code200 Petitioners’ argument that Crowds anticipated by Crowds**
