On November 11, 2021, Defendant filed a motion to stay this matter pending *inter partes* review ("IPR") of the asserted patents. Plaintiff has not opposed the motion. The Court has independently reviewed the record and finds the relevant factors also weigh in favor of granting the motion. Accordingly, the Court GRANTS the motion HEREBY STAYS this matter pending resolution of the IPR proceedings. The parties shall file joint status reports every 180 days until the stay can be lifted, and the first status report shall be due on July 5, 2022.

In light of the stay, the Court TERMINATES Defendant's motion for judgment on the pleadings. If the IPR proceedings do not render that motion moot, the parties shall meet and confer and submit a stipulation and proposed order for a new hearing date on the existing briefing or Defendant may renew that motion to account for any changes necessary.

Finally, the Court reminds all parties that when they seek relief of any form from the Court, they must electronically file proposed orders and submit word documents of those orders to //
