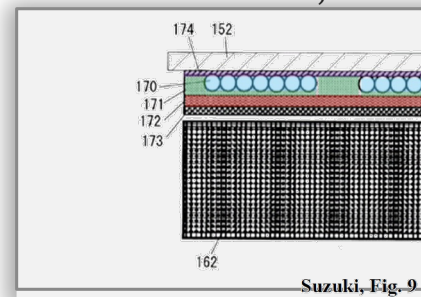

Why Petition Fails

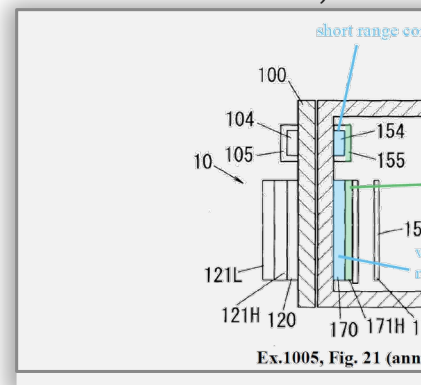
- Suzuki describes each embodiment separately, “in accordance with the [nth] embodiment of the present invention.”

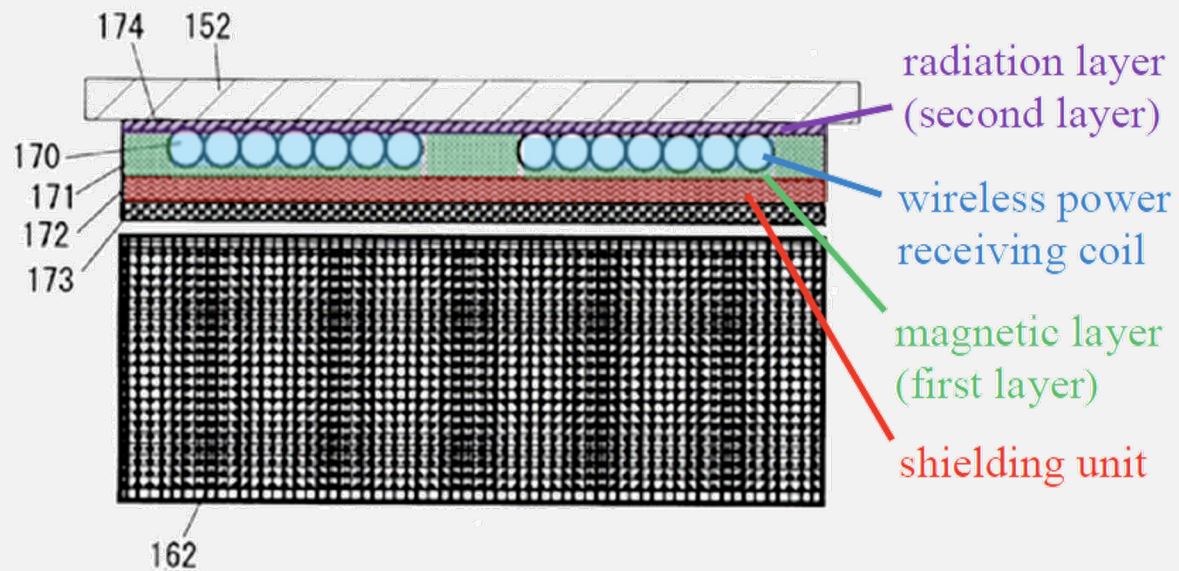
