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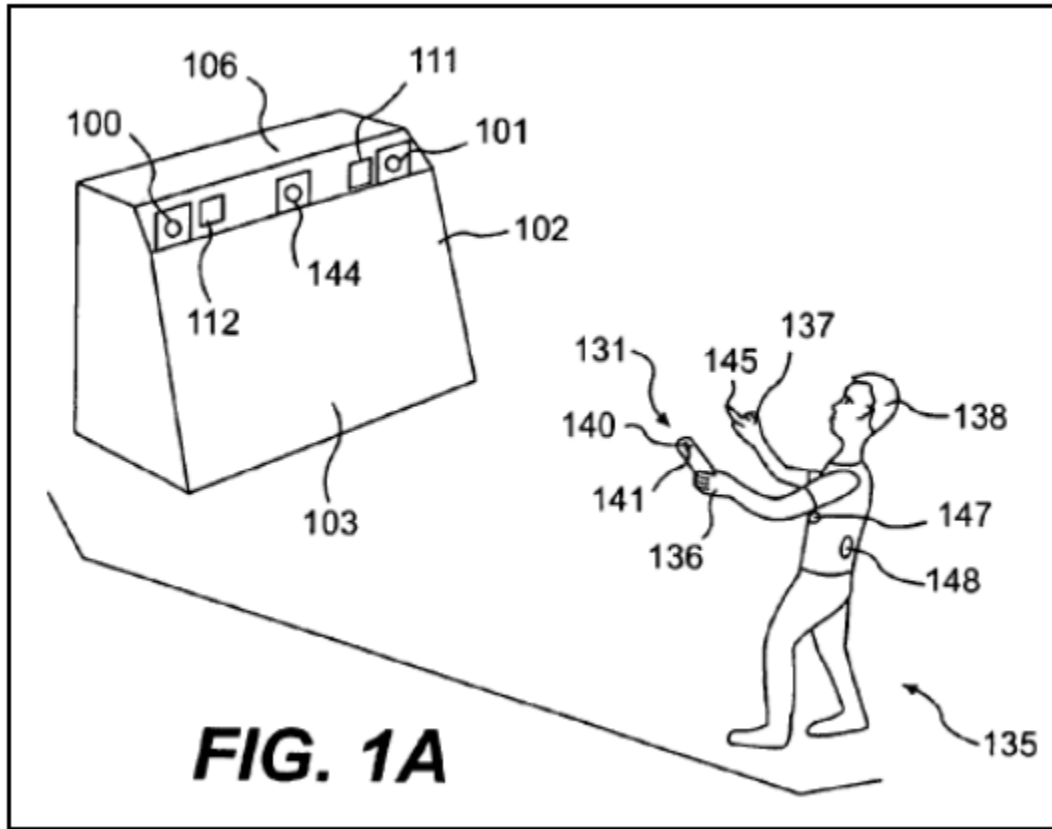
## I. INTRODUCTION

Petitioner ~~Apple Inc.~~ Google LLC (“Petitioner”) requests an *Inter Partes* Review (“IPR”) of claims 1-14 (the “Challenged Claims”) of U.S. Patent No. 8,194,924 (“the ’924 Patent”). This petition is substantively the same as IPR2021-00923 (which is instituted), and is being filed concurrently with a motion for joinder with respect to that proceeding.

## II. SUMMARY OF THE ’924 PATENT

### A. The ’924 Patent’s Alleged Invention

The ’924 Patent describes computer devices that “optically sens[e] human input” using one or more cameras, contemplating applications in a “variety of fields such as computing, gaming, medicine, and education.” *’924 Patent* (Ex. 1001), 2:7—23. A number of scenarios are described, including multiple cameras mounted in a fixed display as depicted in Fig. 1A below and a single camera mounted in a handheld device as depicted in Fig. 8B below:
