'366 Patent, Claim

1. An article of flexible furniture having
 - [a] a core formed from a plurality of laminar panels of a thickness of about 1/8 inch, each panel having a pair of oppositely directed major faces of said panels being inter-connected to provide a cellular structure upon movement of abutting faces away from each other;
 - [b] a pair of supports at opposite ends of said core and connected to respective ones of said faces, said supports being selected to provide rigidity to said core whereby said supports may be used to expand said cellular structure and extend the length of said article flexible so as to be foldable into a tubular configuration parallel to said major faces, and
 - [c] a plurality of fasteners on each of said supports to secure said article in said tubular configuration and to permit connection of said support of another similar article.

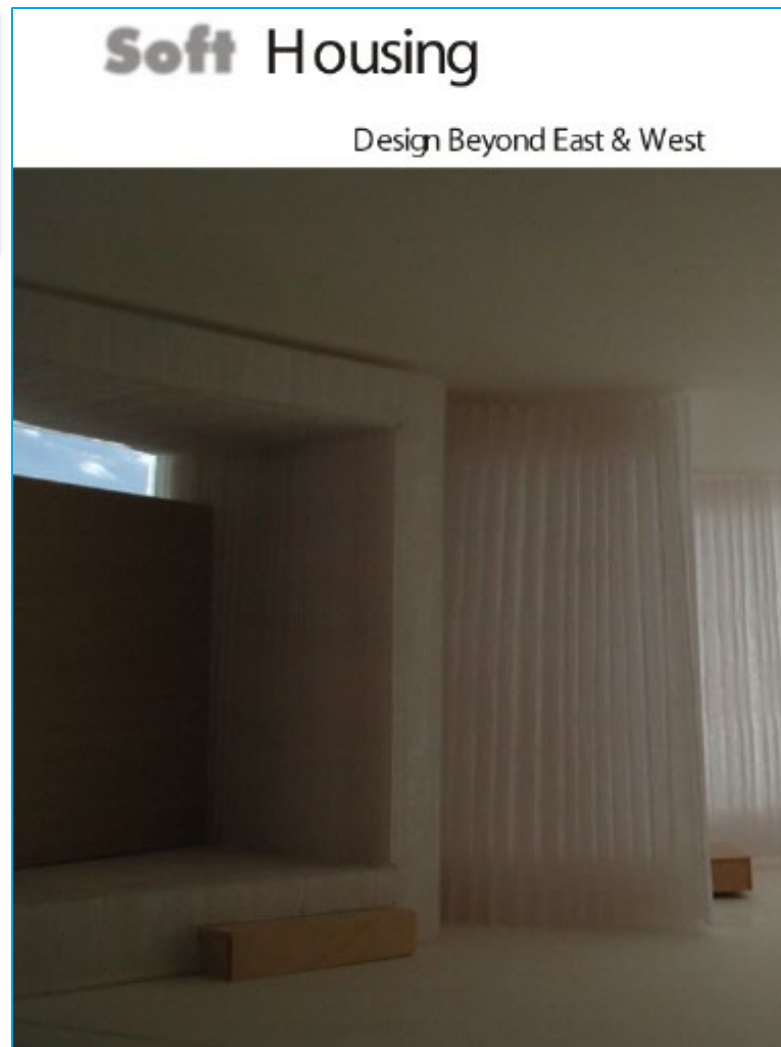

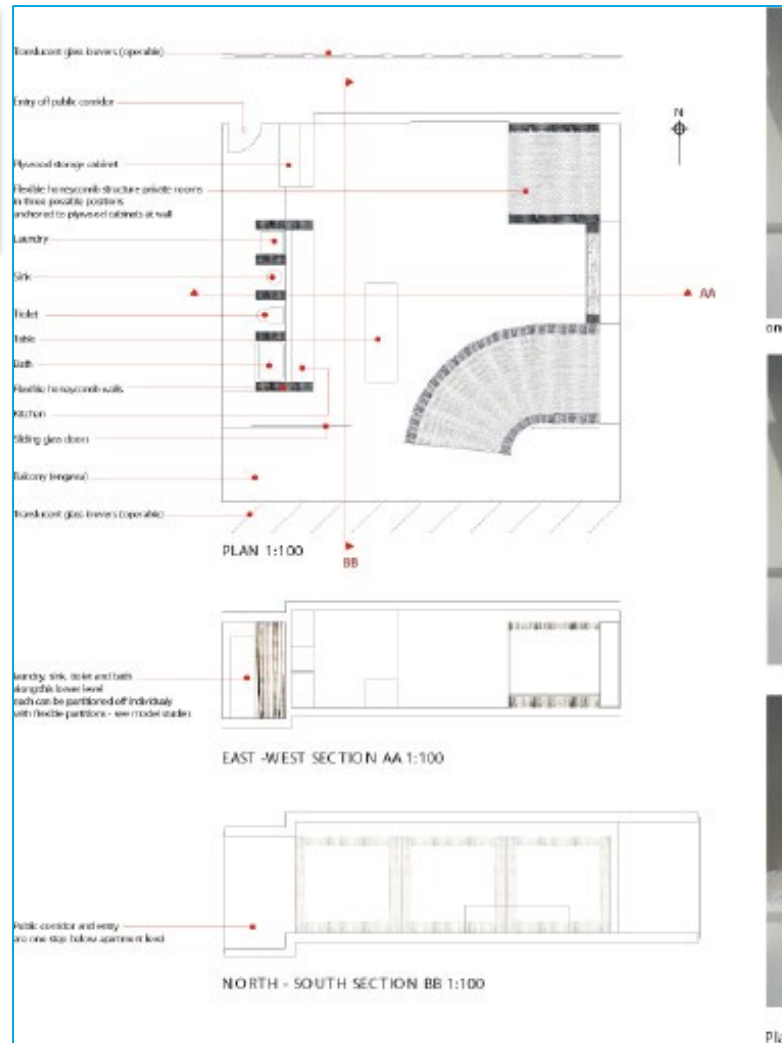
