ORDER
Granting Patent Owner's Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission
of John Petrsoric
37 C.F.R. § 42.10

On June 14, 2023, Patent Owner filed a motion for admission, *pro hac vice*, of John Petrsoric. Paper 27. The oral hearing is scheduled for June 15, 2023. The motion states that Petitioner does not oppose the motion. The motion is supported by the declaration of John Petrsoric (Ex. 2012). We have reviewed the motion and the supporting declaration and find good cause for granting the motion.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED that Patent Owner's motion (Paper 27) for admission *pro hac vice* of John Petrsoric is *granted*, and Mr. Petrsoric is authorized to represent Patent Owner only as back-up counsel in this proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that a registered practitioner will continue to represent Patent Owner as lead counsel in this proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Petrsoric shall comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide, as updated by the Consolidated Trial Practice Guide¹ (84 Fed. Reg. 64,280 (Nov. 21, 2019)), and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Part 42 of Title 37, Code of Federal Regulations;

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Petrsoric shall be subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et seq.*;

FURTHER ORDERED that, within one (1) business day of the date of this order, Petitioner shall file in this proceeding a power of attorney for Mr. Petrsoric in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(b); and

FURTHER ORDERED that, within one (1) business day of the date of this order, Petitioner shall file in this proceeding an updated mandatory notice according to 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(a)–(b), providing updated information regarding back-up counsel.
