**ORDER**

Before the Court is the Joint Motion to Dismiss pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2) (the “Motion”) filed by Plaintiff VARTA Microbattery GmbH (“VARTA”) and Defendants GN Audio A/S and GN Audio USA Inc. d/b/a/ Jabra (collectively, “Jabra”). In the Motion, the parties represent that VARTA and Guangdong Mic-Power New Energy Co., Ltd. (“Mic-Power”) have executed a settlement agreement requiring the dismissal with prejudice of Jabra in this action and seek dismissal with prejudice of this case in its entirety, which relates solely to claims asserted by VARTA against Jabra regarding activities involving Mic-Power microbatteries.

Having considered the Motion, and noting its joint nature, the Court finds that it should be and hereby is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, the above-captioned case is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**, pursuant to the terms of the settlement agreement between VARTA and Mic-Power. Each party is to bear its own costs, expenses, and attorneys’ fees.
