I, Georgios Karamanis, Ph.D., declare as follows:

I. INTRODUCTION AND QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Counsel for Cooler Master Co., Ltd.. ("CMC") has retained me as an expert to offer my opinion regarding the validity of U.S. Patent No. 8,245,764 ("'764 patent"). I submit this declaration based on my personal knowledge and in support of CMC's *inter partes* review Petition against the '764 patent. I previously submitted a substantively identical declaration in support of Shenzhen Apaltek Co. Ltd.'s *inter partes* review Petition against the '764 patent.
- 2. In 2018, I received my Ph.D. from Tufts University in Mechanical Engineering. My Ph.D. thesis was entitled "Nusselt Numbers for Superhydrophobic Microchannels and Shrouded Longitudinal-Fin Heat Sinks."
- 3. In October 2018, I began working at Transport Phenomena Technologies, LLC (TPT) in Medford, MA where I am co-founder and managing member.
- 4. I am currently a Chief Engineer at TPT and responsible for R&D in the area of thermal management of electronics and heat/mass/momentum transfer modeling.
- 5. I am the PI on a National Science Foundation Phase I and its successor Phase II SBIR award (#2025882) and before that on a Massachusetts Clean Energy Center Catalyst award (Spring 2019) relevant to development of software and



hardware for thermal management of electronics.

- 6. I have 10 journal publications most of which are related to thermal management of electronics and liquid cooling. A copy of my Curriculum Vitae ("CV") is submitted herewith as Appendix A, which describes my education, training, and experience in greater detail.
- 7. My primary consulting client is Apaltek, acting as an expert on thermal management in general, including liquid cooling to cool CPUs.
- 8. I have not previously testified as an expert witness in any court or administrative proceeding.
- 9. I am billing my work in this matter at \$200 per hour, with reimbursement for actual expenses. My payment is not contingent upon my testimony or the outcome of the case. I have no personal interest in the outcome of the case.
