Synonyms of *suite* >

1 : RETINUE

especially : the personal staff accompanying a ruler, diplomat, or dignitary on official business

- 2 : a group of things forming a unit or constituting a collection : SET: such as
 - **a** : a group of rooms occupied as a unit
 - **b** (1) : a 17th and 18th century instrumental musical form consisting of a series of dances in the same or related keys
 - (2) : a modern instrumental composition in several movements of different character
 - (3) : a long orchestral concert arrangement in suite form of material drawn from a longer work (such as a ballet)
 - **c** : a collection of minerals or rocks having some characteristic in common (such as type or origin)
 - **d** : a set of matched furniture
 - e : a set of computer programs designed to work together and usually sold as a single unit
