500 watt 120 Volt quartz light with aluminum scaffold mount covers 3,300 square feet. The adjustable aluminum mount can be attached to ladders, ship rails, hand rails, catwalks and scaffolding to facilitate convenient placement of this 12 volt work light. The aluminum rail mount is adjustable from 26 inches to 43 inches to accommodate the spacing between all types of rails. The operator can position the angle of the light both vertically and horizontally a "yolk" enabling the operator to position this explosion proof light at any angle to adequately cover the work area. The rail mount also offers the ability to elevate the light to different heights. Since many handrails are located at waist height, the rail offers the operator the ability to elevate the light when necessary.

25 foot SECOOW (abrasive and oil resistant) cord with standard straight blade plug.

All aluminum ladder bracket hook with adjustable J-hook bottom bracket enables operator to securely mount the light to any rail, ladder or scaffolding. You can adjust the length of the mount between rails. The light is mounted on U-bracket "yolk" with vertical 90 degrees of tilt and 360 degrees of pivot rotation.

The rail mount also offers the ability to elevate the light to different heights. Since many handrails are located at waist height, the rail offers the operator the ability to elevate the light 5 feet above the top mounting rail.

Other applications for this light include catwalks, ship rails, etc. making this explosion proof light useful in ship yards, boat yards, plants, tanks, vessels, fuel cells, bridge repair and oil field applications.
