**ORDER**


Defendants Qualcomm Incorporated, Qualcomm Technologies, Inc., MediaTek USA Inc., MediaTek North America, Inc., D-Link Systems, Inc., Linksys USA, Inc., NETGEAR, Inc., ZyXEL Communications, Inc., and ZyXEL Networks, Inc. (collectively “Defendants”) filed a motion to stay this action, pending resolution of a parallel proceeding in the United States International Trade Commission (“ITC”), pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1659 and this Court’s discretionary power. Plaintiff Bell Northern Research, LLC (“Plaintiff”) does not oppose Defendants’ motion.

Upon consideration, the Court finds there to be good cause to grant Defendants’ motion and stay this action. Accordingly, this action is stayed as to all parties pending resolution of the parallel proceeding, captioned *In the Matter of Certain Electronic Devices and Semiconductor Devices Having Wireless Communication Capabilities and Components Thereof*, Inv. No. 337-TA-1367 (the “1367 Investigation”), at the ITC.

The parties are directed to file a joint status report within thirty days of the resolution of the 1367 Investigation.
