The motion to join will agree to take an understudy role and, in order to maintain consistency between the proceedings, will agree to be bound by both the schedule of the prior art stipulation the Petitioners filed in the -00137 proceeding (IPR2024-00137, Paper 1 at 62). This stipulation will replace the one Samsung filed in the IPR2024-00315 proceeding (IPR2024-00315, Paper 8).
