Plaintiff's Final Election of Asserted Claims shall identify no more than five asserted claims per patent from among the eight previously identified claims and no more than a total of sixteen asserted claims

May 6, 2024	June 5, 2024	<p>*File Notice of Request for Daily Transcript or Real Time Reporting.</p> <p>If a daily transcript or real time reporting of court proceedings is requested for trial, the party or parties making said request shall file a notice with the Court and e- mail the Court Reporter, Shelly Holmes, at shelly_holmes@txed.uscourts.gov.</p>

April 29, 2024	June 5, 2024	File Motions <i>in Limine</i> The parties shall limit their motions <i>in limine</i> to issues that if improperly introduced at trial would be so prejudicial that the Court could not alleviate the prejudice by giving appropriate instructions to the jury.
April 29, 2024	June 5, 2024	Serve Objections to Rebuttal Pretrial Disclosures
April 22, 2024	May 29, 2024	Serve Objections to Pretrial Disclosures; and Serve Rebuttal Pretrial Disclosures
April 1, 2024	May 29, 2024	Response to Dispositive Motions (including <i>Daubert</i> Motions). Responses to dispositive motions that were filed <u>prior</u> to the dispositive motion deadline, including <i>Daubert</i> Motions, shall be due in accordance with Local Rule CV- 7(e), not to exceed the deadline as set forth in this Docket Control Order. ² Motions for Summary Judgment shall comply with Local Rule CV-56.
