On January 27, 2020, the Board issued an Order pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.5 ordering that the cross-examination of Patent Owner's declarant, Mr. Joseph Posillico, shall take place no later than January 30, 2020. Paper 68 ("Order"), 5. Also that day, Petitioner contacted the Board via email notifying the Board that Mr. Posillico's cross-examination will take place on January 31, 2020. Ex. 3003. In its email, Petitioner states:

ORDERED that a cross-examination of Mr. Joseph Posillico shall take place no later than January 31, 2020.
