MR. HOUSTON: -- from the claims spawns two implied or really direct claim construction issues as raised by patent owner in their preliminary response. One is a discussion of what is meant by dielectric grains and then the other is what is meant by single dielectric layer, and so those are the two issues, they both stem from the same limitation. With respect to the dielectric grains issue, well for neither of those, Your Honor, has patent owner proposed formal constructions, but instead as they discussed prior art, they adopt implied constructions for those terms that would, that attempt to distinguish those claim limitations from the prior art. With respect to the first one, dielectric grains --
