REQUEST FOR FIRST EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE NOTICE OF OPPOSITION

Apple Computer, Inc., a Delaware corporation, having its principal place of business at 1 Infinite Loop, Cupertino, California 95014, by and through its attorneys hereby requests that the Board grant a sixty (60) day extension of time to file a Notice of Opposition to registration of the APPLE AWARDS trademark by applicant in the above-referenced case.
