#### REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION

This responds to the Office Action dated December 14, 2017. The Applicant has entered an amendment to the specification of goods in accordance with the Trademark Examining Attorney's requirements.

Applicant respectfully disagrees with the Trademark Examining Attorney's continued characterization of Applicant's mark as confusing with the cited prior registration for AX. There is no evidence in the record that the parties' respective marks have similar commercial impressions.

The Trademark Office in its initial characterization of the literal elements of the mark has characterized the mark as an A mark. Although the stylized mark of Applicant is clearly an "A" and the tail at the end could be considered an x (mirroring Applicant's name, Athenex), there is no reason to conclude that consumers would consider it as an AX, and in particular no evidence of record that the relevant consuming public would consider the stylized mark to be a "play" on Rx. — its highly stylized mark could be viewed as the first letter and last letter of Applicant's name — Athenex — that counters any argument that consumers would view the mark as a play on Rx. In prosecution, it is the Trademark Examining Attorney's burden to make the leap — concluding that both marks although clearly not identical — would be perceived as confusingly similar. The Trademark Examining Attorney offers no evidence that a pharmaceutical mark of any kind — which is composed of two letters — the second of which is as X would be considered by the consuming public to give the impression of the term Rx.

There is in fact no reason that a consumer would look at the mark as an AX mark at all – except if the consumer connects the mark with Applicant's highly stylized logo for Athenex. The design of the mark may from a purely design perspective be evocative of two letters – but the stylization is so completely different from the cited registration, or from an impression of an AX generally as to be insignificant. It is the commercial impression of the mark in the marketplace that is significant only.,

Indeed, there are many stylized A marks on the Register that are for pharmaceutical products. There are many companies that have an A and an X as part of their names. The coexistence of all of these marks on the register shows clearly that the commercial impressions of stylized A marks that have possible X elements are considered commercially distinct and non-confusing marks. By the Examining Attorney's logic, none of the above noted marks could co-exist on the register for pharmaceutical products.

Moreover, where highly stylized marks are compared, the individual letters (to the extent that those letters are immediately notable) are relevant only if the commercial impressions are such that the marks are likely to be confused. Applicant's mark would not be immediately notable as an AX to a consumer – any more than the list of registrations and applications would be immediately notable as such. Without question, the prominent feature of Applicant's mark is its highly stylized A. That dominant feature carries the commercial impression of Applicant's mark. The parties' marks must be compared in their entireties, with regard to their appearance, sound, connotation and commercial impression. Palm Bay Imports, Inc. v. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Maison Fondee en 1772, 73 USPTO 1689, 1692 (Fed. Cir. 2005). There is nothing improper in stating that for rational reasons more or less weight is given to a particular feature of a mark in analyzing whether two marks are confusingly similar. See In re Nat'l Data Corp., 224 USPQ 749, 751 (Fed. Cir. 1985). The marks would not in fact be pronounced at all by the relevant consumers. They would only be viewed and therefore the appearance, connotation and commercial impression are the most important. The marks are completely distinct visually. With respect to Applicant's mark, the predominant element is a highly stylized A. Here, there is no dispute that in Applicant's mark the "A" is dominant. It is only when one looks at the mark in connection with the Applicant's complete name in its stylized form that a consumer may make an association that the crossed curve at the bottom is an "X." There could be no conclusion that the crossed line is an "X" of Rx, or that Applicant's mark would be viewed by consumers as a playful Rx. The visual differences alone are sufficient to weigh strongly against a conclusion of likelihood of confusion. *ProMark Brands Inc. and H.J. Heinz Company v. GFA Brands, Inc.*, 114 USPQ 2d. 1232, 1242 (TTAB 2015).

Contrary to the Trademark Examining Attorney's position --- there is no different analysis for marks that are used in association with pharmaceuticals. It is of course an obvious issue when two marks are used as brand names for individual drugs – the determination of confusion in that case is best reviewed by the FDA, which is charged with reviewing drug names for consumer confusion. However, here, the mark in question is used as a house mark to identify a drug manufacturer and the line of drugs offered thereunder. Applicant has used its stylized mark for upwards of three years in the marketplace without confusion with the cited registrant or any other manufacturer.

It is respectfully requested that the Trademark Examining Attorney reconsider her refusal and permit the mark to proceed to publication. A Notice of Appeal is filed concurrently herewith.
