LOCAL RULE 103.3

3. Disclosure of Affiliations and Financial Interest

When filing an initial pleading or promptly after learning of the information to be disclosed, counsel shall submit to the Clerk two copies of a written statement (separate from any pleading) containing the following information:

- a. Corporate affiliations. The identity of any parent or other affiliate of a corporate party and the description of the relationship between the party and such affiliates.
- b. Financial interests in the outcome of the litigation. The identity of any corporation, unincorporated association, partnership or other business entity, not a party to the case, which may have any financial interest whatsoever in the outcome of litigation and the nature of its financial interest. The term "financial interest in the outcome of the litigation" includes a potential obligation of an insurance company or other person to represent or to indemnify any party to the case. Any notice given to the Clerk under this Rule shall not be considered as an admission by the insurance company or other person that it does in fact have an obligation to defend the litigation or to indemnify a party or as a waiver of any rights that it might have in connection with the subject matter of the litigation.
