In its order mailed November 13, 2013, the Board allowed applicant time to submit opposer's written consent to applicant's proposed amendment. In response thereto, on December 9, 2013, opposer submitted its written consent and its withdrawal of the opposition with prejudice.

Accordingly, by the proposed amendment applicant seeks to delete the words, "pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of gastro-intestinal diseases and conditions," such that the identification of goods is amended to read:

"Pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of respiratory diseases and conditions, anti-inflammatory preparations, antiphlogistic preparations, anti-allergic preparations, analgesic preparations, anti-rheumatic preparations, pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of cardiovascular diseases and conditions, pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of cancer, pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of diabetes, pharmaceutical preparations for the treatment of osteoporosis."



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Inasmuch as the amendment is clearly limiting in nature as required by Trademark Rule 2.71(a), and because opposer consents thereto, it is approved and entered. See Trademark Rule 2.133(a).

The contingency in opposer's withdrawal having now been met, the opposition is dismissed with prejudice.
